La Palma Seeks Residents for Committee Vacancies

LA PALMA, Calif. – Citizens of the City of La Palma are invited to submit applications for current and upcoming vacancies on two Council Appointed Committees – the Community Activities and Beautification Committee and the Traffic Safety Committee. There are no current or upcoming vacancies on the City's Development Committee.

The Community Activities and Beautification (CAB) Committee works with City staff to coordinate City special events including Memorial Day, Concerts in the Park, and the annual Holiday Tree Lighting event. CAB committee members also assist the City in planning the annual La Palma Days event. CAB members meet on the second Tuesday of each month from September to June. The CAB Committee currently has two vacancies, with two-year terms that will expire on December 31, 2016. Up to three CAB vacancies may be filled by youth representatives with one-year terms.

The role of the Traffic Safety Committee is to identify and make recommendations to the Council on improvements in La Palma traffic conditions. The Traffic Safety Committee meets quarterly, with special meetings conducted on an as-needed basis. Two vacancies, with four-year terms expiring December 3, 2018, will be created when the incumbents' terms expire on December 31 of 2014.
