



Senate Bill 54

- **Prohibits local law enforcement agencies from using money or personnel for specified immigration enforcement purposes including:**
 - Inquiring about immigration status
 - Detain someone for federal government unless for a felony warrant or other crime listed in Trust Act
 - Participate in joint task forces with federal government if primary purpose is immigration enforcement
- **DOES NOT prohibit local law enforcement from:**
 - Investigating, enforcing, detaining, or arresting an individual who unlawfully enters or attempts to reenter the United States following removal based upon conviction of a federal felony, provided that such entry or attempted reentry is detected during unrelated law enforcement activity
 - Responding to a request for information about a specific individual's criminal history where otherwise permitted by law
 - Conducting enforcement or investigative duties in connection with a joint law enforcement task force, provided that certain conditions are met
