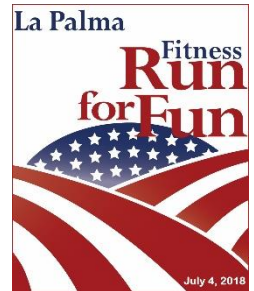

- Moody Street –Number 2 northbound lane (Houston to Crescent) starting at 5:00 a.m.
- Crescent Avenue –Number 2 westbound lane (Moody to Walker) starting at 5:00 a.m.
