- **Possible wearing a gray jacket, unknown color t-shirt, blue jeans, and blue/orange shoes**

Scott Jenkins was last seen at 8:00 a.m. this morning in the area of La Palma Avenue and Denni Street in La Palma. He does not drive, but is known to walk and take the bus. He also might be traveling to the Tustin or Santa Ana area, where family lives.
