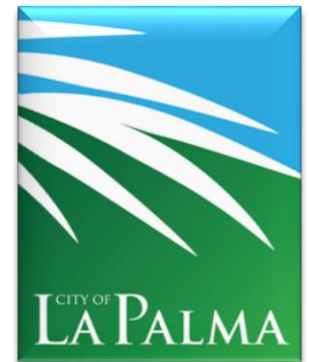

Recommendation

Recommending City Council support:

- 1. AB 143 (Quirk-Silva) – Shelter Crisis: homelessness: County of Orange**
- 2. AB 563 (Quirk-Silva) – Mental health: funding**
- 3. AB 816 (Quirk-Silva) – California Flexible Housing Subsidy Pool Program**
- 4. AB 1295 (Quirk-Silva) – Temporary housing and support services program**
- 5. S. 923 (Feinstein) – Fighting Homelessness Through Services and Housing Act**
- 6. SB 230 (Caballero) – Law enforcement: use of deadly force: training: policies**
- 7. AB 21 (Oberholte) – Driver’s licenses: veteran designation**



Recommendation

Recommending City Council oppose:

- 1. AB 68 (Ting) – Land use: accessory dwelling units**
- 2. AB 1279 (Bloom) – Planning and zoning: housing development: high-resource areas**
- 3. AB 1763 (Chiu) – Planning and zoning: density bonuses: affordable housing**
- 4. SB 50 (Weiner) – Planning and zoning: housing development: incentives**
- 5. AB 302 (Berman) – Parking: homeless students**
- 6. AB 392 (Weber) – Peace officers: deadly force**
- 7. AB 1332 (Bonta) – Sanctuary State Contracting and Investment Act**
