La Palma Honors Veterans at Memorial Day Ceremony

LA PALMA, Calif. – On Monday, May 27, 2019, the City of La Palma hosted its annual Memorial Day Ceremony in front of the Eternal Flame and Memory Garden at the Civic Center. The City has hosted this prestigious event since 1972, honoring those who paid the ultimate sacrifice for our freedoms. Also recognized at the event were past and present La Palma veterans.

This year's ceremony included a keynote address from Major Howard Medina, Executive Officer of the Headquarters and Headquarters Battalion, 40th Infantry Division at Los Alamitos Joint Forces Training Base.
