NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the City of La Palma City Council will conduct a Public Hearing on Tuesday, November 19, 2019, at 7:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers of City Hall, 7822 Walker Street, La Palma, California, for the purpose of reviewing and adopting the following:

**An Ordinance Repealing Divisions 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, and 11, of Article III of Chapter 10 of the La Palma City Code, and adding thereto new Divisions 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 of Article III of Chapter 10 adopting by reference the 2019 Editions of the California Administrative Code (CAC); the California Building Code (CBC); the California Mechanical Code (CMC); the California Plumbing Code (CPC); the California Electrical Code (CEC); the California Residential Code (CRC); the California Energy Code (CEnC); the California Green Building Standards Code (CGBSC); and the California Referenced Standards Code (CRSC) and certain appendices; the 2018 Edition of the International Swimming Pool and Spa Code; the 2018 Edition of the International Property Maintenance Code, (Hereinafter referred to collectively as “Codes”); together with certain amendments, additions, deletions, and exceptions thereto.**

At said Public Hearing, all public comments in either oral or written form and either favoring or opposing the proposed Ordinance will be heard.
