City of La Palma Seeking City Council Candidates

LA PALMA, Calif. – A General Municipal Election will be held in the City of La Palma on Tuesday, November 3, 2020, to fill three City Council seats. Elections for the La Palma City Council are held every two years, and terms for the City Council's five at-large seats are staggered. Therefore, all five council seats are not up for election during the same election year.

The filing period for nominations began Monday, July 13, and closes at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, August 7, 2020.
