La Palma City Council Breaks Ground on New Starbucks

LA PALMA, Calif. – On March 4, 2021, the La Palma City Council and other local officials joined together to celebrate the groundbreaking of La Palma’s first Starbucks Coffee Company.

Located on the southeast corner of Orangethorpe Avenue and Moody Street, the new Starbucks will consist of a single-story building totaling 895 square feet, which will serve customers via a drive-through lane and walk-up windows. Other improvements to the property will include outdoor seating as well as new landscaping and contemporary signage. Starbucks is expected to open this summer.

“The City Council and I are thrilled that Starbucks has chosen La Palma for their place of business,” Mayor Nitesh P. Patel stated. “This location will complete the last undeveloped corner of Orangethorpe Avenue and Moody Street, and we look forward to continuing the City’s economic growth in 2021.”
