NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Tuesday, November 1, 2022, at 6:30 P.M., the City Council of the City of La Palma will conduct a Public Hearing at the Council Chambers, City Hall, 7822 Walker Street, La Palma, California, on the following matter:

An Ordinance of the City Council of the City of La Palma, California repealing Article III of Chapter 10 of the La Palma Municipal Code, and adding thereto a new Article III of Chapter 10 adopting by reference the 2022 Editions of the California Codes and related Model Codes which include the California Building, Residential, Energy, Green Building Standards, Plumbing, Mechanical, Electrical, Existing Building Codes, the International Property Maintenance Code, and the Uniform Code for Abatement of Dangerous Building, with appendices and amendments thereto. *

*Pursuant to Section 15061(b) (3) [14 C.C.R. § 15061(b)(3)] of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), this project is categorically exempt from CEQA Review.

If you are interested in participating or listening to the Public Hearing, please follow the instructions on the first page of the November 1, 2022, agenda that will be posted on October 27, 2022. Copies of the primary code and also copies of the secondary codes, if any, being considered for adoption, are on file with the City Clerk of the City of La Palma, and are open to public inspection. All agenda materials will be available for review 72 hours in advance of the scheduled hearing at La Palma City Hall and on the City's website at www.cityoflapalma.org.
