NOTICE OF ADOPTION**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that on Tuesday, October 4, 2022, at 6:30 P.M., the City Council of the City of La Palma conducted a Public Meeting at the Council Chambers, City Hall, 7822 Walker Street, La Palma, California, and adopted an Ordinance to amend portions of the La Palma Municipal Code. A summary of the Ordinance is as follows:

**An Ordinance of the City Council of the City of La Palma amending Section 2.8 of Article 1 Chapter 2 of the La Palma Municipal Code pursuant to California Government Code Section 34886, providing for the election of members of the City Council of the City of La Palma by-district in five single-member districts, in furtherance of the purposes of the California Voting Rights Act of 2001 (Chapter 1.5 (commencing with Section 14025) of Division 14 of the Elections Code) and to implement the guarantees of Section 7 of Article 1 and of Section of Article II of the California Constitution. The ordinance allows the voting district maps and the election date sequence for each of the districts to be adopted by resolution.**

This Ordinance will go into effect 30 days after it's adopted and By-District elections will commence in 2024.
