Debbie Baker Selected as La Palma Mayor for 2023; Marshall Goodman as Mayor Pro Tem

LA PALMA, Calif. – At its regular meeting on December 13, 2022, the La Palma City Council selected Debbie Baker as Mayor and at a special meeting on December 20, 2022, selected Marshall Goodman as Mayor Pro Tem for 2023. Re-elected Council Member Nitesh Patel and newly elected Council Member Janet Conklin were also sworn in to begin their four-year terms on December 13.



Mayor Baker said, “I certainly want to say it's been a pleasure working with you all this year, and I am looking forward to continuing the good work the Council and staff provide to the La Palma community.” Mayor Baker was elected to the City Council in November 2020.

Mayor Pro Tem Marshall Goodman shared the sentiments of Mayor Baker and stated he also is looking forward to working with the Council to continue to make La Palma one of the best places to live. Mayor Pro Tem Goodman was first elected to the City Council in 2016. Earlier this year, Mayor Pro Tem Goodman was also elected to the League of California Cities Board of Directors.
