

2022 Orange County Progress Report Addendum

Subsequent to the release of the 2022 Orange County Progress Report, the California State Department of Finance (DOF) released their revised *E-5 Population and Housing Estimates for Cities, Counties, and the State, January 2021-2022, with 2020 Benchmark* in May 2022. These were benchmarked to the 2020 Decennial Census, which resulted in significant changes to city-level estimates. Below are the revised, benchmarked estimates that replace previous estimates and their locations within the report.
